Primary and General Elections: The Primary Election is held on the 3rd Tuesday in May, 8:00AM to 8:00PM and the General Election is held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 8:00AM to 8:00PM in even numbered years only. School districts may hold elections in March, May, August and November (for specific dates, please call the Latah County Clerk's Office). Other taxing district elections, such as school, library, cemetery, highway, recreation, fire and water and sewer may hold bond/levy/other ballot question elections at the May primary, and November general election dates of consolidation. Voter Qualifications

1. United States citizenship.
2. 18 years of age or older on or before Election Day.
3. Resident of Idaho and a resident in the county for 30 days prior to the election.
4. Duly registered. Voters must register or re-register to vote if they have changed their name, changed their address, or not voted in any primary or general election in the last four years.

Voter Registration

Voters may register in person at the office of the County Clerk up to the 25th day prior to an election.

Voters may register by mail, using an application which is available at the Latah County Clerk's Office, at the drivers' license offices, local libraries and city halls and on-line at www.latah.id.us/elections. Mail-in applications must be *post-marked* at least 25 days before the election.

On Election Day voters may register in their precinct at the polls by showing any document containing a valid address in the precinct, together with a picture ID card, OR by signing a Personal Identification Affidavit at the time they vote at the polling place in order to receive a ballot.

Absentee Voting and Voting in Advance

Absentee ballots are available up to 5:00PM on the Friday before the election. Voters may have a ballot mailed to them by applying to the Latah County Clerk's Office in person, or by mailing the application to the office of the County Clerk. (for an application, see website listed above). As there is a new state law regarding the declaration of party affiliation for the Primary Election, please view the *Idaho Political Party Affiliation Declaration Form*.

This can be accessed at the Idaho Secretary of State's web site: www.idahovotes.gov/VoterReg/affiliation_form.pdf. Voters may register and/or vote in person during the 25 days prior to the election at the voting booth in the Latah County Clerk's Office until 5:00PM the Friday before the election. Voters may register during the 25 days prior to the election only if they vote absentee at the same time. A photo ID is required.

About the League
