

ISCA Spring Round Up Minutes April 5, 2008

President Shane Minden called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm, at the Benewah County Fairgrounds in St. Maries, Idaho.

Minutes were read. A motion to accept minutes was made by Connie Minden seconded by Vicki Pennington. All in favor to approve.

Treasurer's Report: as of 4/4/08 Savings holds \$1,032.00 and Checking holds \$2,933.55. The following clubs have donated these amounts to be used for Awards for the state show: KCSC \$500 C-F \$300, Cayuse Kids \$100, Myra Metcalf \$100, Myla Nailon \$100, Benewah Saddle Club \$100 NWSOA \$250 & Upriver Saddle Club \$200.

Individual event awards were shown at this time. They are all tack items for 1st places, and 2nd through 5th will be medallions. We can only afford 1 Hi Point award at this time. Monies spent so far are \$1,700 on awards. We will do the best we can to get more as more clubs donate and more money becomes available. Much discussion on how much more was needed to get some more awards in before the show.

Myra Metcalf explained the raffle tickets and showed everyone 2 Craig Wicks hangers to be raffled off. Drawing will be held on Sunday at the Awards Ceremony.

Clarification was asked for on what dollar amount is in the awards fund. \$1300 was transferred out for awards from savings. \$570 was turned in from KCSC for their \$1.00 fee from 07 State Show.

We will be running 4 lanes at State show.

Mail entries to Kim McLaughlin, address is listed on entry forms which are available now.

All properties are okay at SMSC arena.

There are 24 stalls available and we can build portable ones as well at \$5.00 Each.

Minimal Camping available at \$10.00 All are 1st come first serve basis.

No Charge for vendors to come.

Shane asked if St Maries Saddle Club would be willing to run their cook Shack for the weekend and give a percentage of the profit to ISCA. The SMSC members in attendance did not believe that their club would be willing to pay a percentage to run it. Kim McLaughlin asked why it would be fair for them to profit possibly thousands of dollars off of their cook shack and dance when none of the other clubs stood to profit anything. Especially when SMSC have at this point have donated nothing for the awards. Much discussion on what would be a fair percentage which resulted in 40% to SMSC and 60% to ISCA if the SMSC members choose to open their cook shack. Other option discussed was to open a cook shack as ISCA and have members from each club donate time to run it just like we take turns for each event.

Gregg Calvert at this time offered to match any donation up to \$400 from here til the state show. This money will go straight towards awards. Thank you Gregg. This move inspired Tyanne Jacklin to offer \$300 and UpRiver Saddle Club to donate \$200 more.

Michelle Bronson told everyone about KCSC new Barrel and Pole races. There will be money added for each open in the amount of \$500 and we will be following IEBRA rules. There is also a committee in place to help put gaming people in the correct divisions to make fairness a priority. We have flyers and nomination forms, or visit our site at www.kcsaddleclub.com.

Visiting Royalty introductions were made at this time. Royalty came from Cayuse Kids, Upriver, Silver Spurs, C-F Riding Club, and KCSC.
