Proposals for 2012 Idaho Saddle Club Association

Results - Feb 4, 2012

- +++++
1. I propose that all submitted proposals be sponsored by at least one member of an ISCA club.

Explanation: Too often at the Winter meeting when the proposals are being discussed there is no clear idea of what is intended by submitted proposals. This way if there was any confusion leading up to the Winter meeting the sponsor could be contacted should any clarification be needed. (Shane Minden)

Add to ISCA Bylaws, Article IV, Section 2

- +++++
2. In reference to the ground rule from 4/3/2010 concerning the attendance by the ISCA Royalty at the annual October meeting I propose rewording the **ISCA Royalty Guide** concerning attendance of meetings to read: ISCA Royalty shall be required to attend all ISCA general meetings (Winter meeting, Spring Roundup, June meeting and October meeting, if one is held). (Shane Minden)

Explanation: The idea of having a meeting in October was mainly to discuss the pending NSCA proposals, and since the ISCA rarely receives the NSCA proposals in time to organize such a meeting it has not been followed through on. Also the royalty guide is rather wordy and this would eliminate some repetitiveness.

3. I propose that ISCA amend its rule concerning the wearing of hats to read: Cowboy hats or approved riding helmets may be worn during competition but are not required. Caps or visors are not permitted. Cowboy hats that are lost in the arena while competing will result in a disqualification for that event. (Shane Minden)

Explanation: This is in reference to 2011 NSCA Rule Recommendation Equipment & Attire - add 7. Western Attire may include a cowboy hat, cap, or visor. Hats worn during an event that are lost in the arena will result in a disqualification of the contestant in that event.

Passed - (2) Nays

ISCA Rules and Regulations: delete #13 and #14, this would become #26 (there is no #2 in the rules and regulations)

- 4. I propose that the ISCA Officers and appointed committee members host the annual Idaho State O-Mok-See with the site to be determined at the annual Winter meeting. Any club or venue wishing for the State O-Mok-See to held at their location is to submit a written proposal to the ISCA Secretary by October 1st. Proposal is to include arena specifications, site amenities, event property inventory. Any requested fees or other special requests of the ISCA are to also be included. Host venue would receive all profits from concessions not sold by ISCA. (Shane Minden)

All passed

The best place for this to be located that I can see is in the ISCA Host Club Responsibilities, would replace the existing information in #1.

- 5. I propose that there be a deadline of Four weeks following the annual Winter meeting for all event dates (including contact information) to be submitted to the ISCA for inclusion on that years ISCA Events Calendar. The calendar, in turn, will be completed and posted to the ISCA website no later than four weeks following the Winter meeting. Any changes to these dates will be made on the ISCA calendar as time permits.

Explanation: Every year, in an effort to assure that all clubs dates are included on the calendar, ISCA personnel spends a substantial amount of time contacting each club to collect this information and then even more time is spent making changes to the calendar for various reasons. During this time ISCA receives a large number of phone calls from people attempting to plan their summer activities. By imposing said deadlines we can hopefully alleviate some of the hassle, as well as impatient/rude contact imposed on ISCA personnel.

Once again, there is no clear cut place for this to be put. I would recommend that it be added to the duties of either the ISCA Secretary (By-Laws; Article VI; Section 5) or ISCA Historian (By-Laws; Article VI; Section 7)

- 6. In consideration of all participants and committee members of the ISCA O-Mok-See I propose that any proposed and approved extra-curricular activities not sanctioned by the ISCA (i.e. Championship Polebending, Jackpot barrels etc) be ran only during the evening before the start of the ISCA O-Mok-See (Friday night) or if there is time permitting after the completion of all ISCA functions (i.e awards, general membership meeting etc.) on the dates of the ISCA O-Mok-See. Also if there are proposed extra-curricular events all rules pertaining to these events are to be submitted, in clear and concise wording, to the ISCA board at the time of the submission of their bid to host the annual ISCA O-Mok-See.

7. I propose that any proposed extra-curricular activities not sanctioned by the ISCA (i.e. Championship Polebending, Jackpot barrels etc) shall only be approved if all rules and how winner will be determined, including but not limited to calculations/times/age groups are used to determine winner. These clear and concise rules must be included on the entry form. The ISCA board shall approve the entry form. (Kim O.)
